## **Utility Coordination Guidelines** (Revised 5-26-2015)

Please submit to Town of Marana separate CD/DVDs evidencing prior rights in the public rights of way for

- 1.) abutting/adjacent State Trust Land parcels and
- 2.) private and public parcels and public right of way.

Save documents individually in **.pdf** format on each disk. Utilities shall provide a narrative regarding gaps in utility prior rights on this project <u>or</u> the lack of prior rights by citing the nearest Station noted on the project plans.

As-Built plans and supporting, recorded documentation for State Trust Land and Pima County Recorder shall be submitted together.

The deadline for meeting these utility requirements is March 31, 2015.

## Private or Public Parcels and Public Rights of Way:

Submit a separate CD/DVD evidencing prior rights on private and public parcels and in public rights of way.

## AZ State Land Parcels:

Submit a separate CD/DVD evidencing prior rights in the public rights of way at or along State Trust Land parcels or State Trust Land roadways.

- Any trespass on State Trust Land must be remedied by the utility or enterprise with the State Land Department for lack of prior rights.
- Assignments of RW Lease to successor, legal entities <u>must</u> be documented by a copy of the <u>accepted ASLD application</u> and <u>the final, approved ASLD lease</u>.
- **All utilities**, including fiber optic, cable and cell carriers, are required to file a Utilities ASLD Application (*RW-U*) for this project in order to locate overhead and subsurface on State Trust parcels or in rights of way owned by State Trust Land.
